WW-II there was 34 tribes. 10 from my reservation were in the Army. I am sure there were in all services. The Hopi were all in the Army. There were 29 Navaho Code Talkers to start with, in the Marines and 340 total. We must not forget our Code Talkers. I served from 1957 to 1966. My last two years in the air wing. It was like two different services. Everyone was going by first name and not by ranks.
